## TOWN OF PALISADE RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-08

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF PALISADE, COLORADO, TERMINATING THE COVID-19 LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2020-07 the Town of Palisade (the "Town") Board of Trustees (the "Board") declared a Local Disaster Emergency pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709 to enable responsive measures to the COVID-19 pandemic and accompanying hardships on the community; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2020-08 the Board adopted an Emergency Electronic Participation Policy to allow Board and Commission meetings to occur over remote electronic communication platforms during a declared local disaster emergency ("Electronic Participation"); and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has abated and normal functioning of governments, including the Town, has resumed; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it proper to terminate the Local Disaster Emergency declaration.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALISADE, COLORADO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Incorporation of Recitals</u>. The above recitals are hereby incorporated as findings by the Town of Palisade

Section 2. Termination of Local Disaster Emergency. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Palisade hereby terminates the Local Disaster Emergency declared under Resolution No. 2020-07, which shall become effective August 9, 2021.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Emergency Electronic Participation Policy</u>. By operation of law, and pursuant to Resolution No 2020-8, Electronic Participation is no longer authorized for Town meetings upon the effective date of the termination of the Local Disaster Emergency.

<u>Section 4.</u> File Resolution. This Resolution shall be promptly filed with the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
