In February 2021, we recycled 6 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard.

Recycling these materials will save the following resources:

96 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 1,627,700 sheets of printing and copy paper!

14 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 16 people!

12,184 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

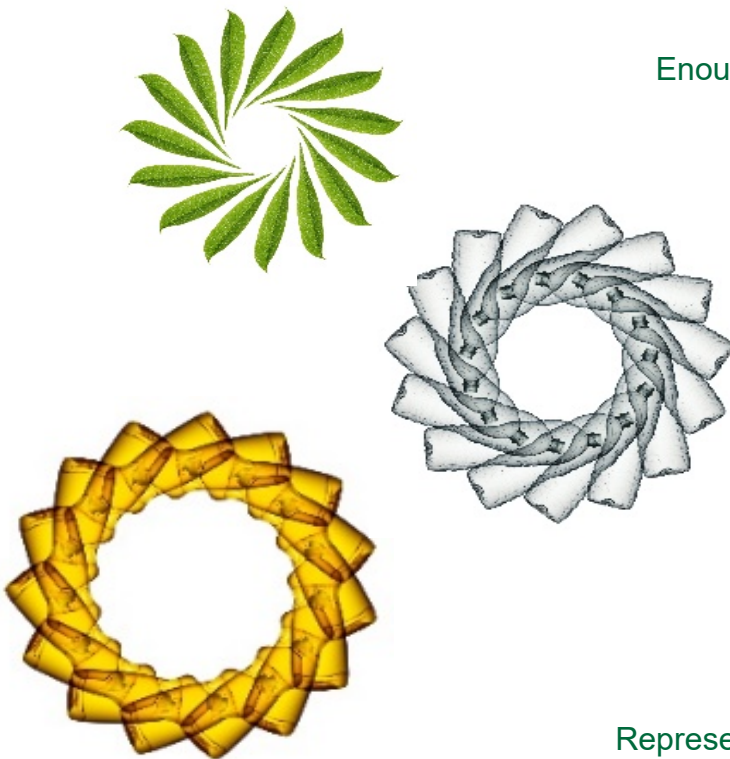
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 1 homes!

Avoided 16 Metric Tons (MTCO₂E) of GHG Emissions

The recycling of these materials prevented these GHG emissions!

29,160 Gallons of Water

Represents enough saved water to meet the daily fresh water needs of 388 people!
