## Palisade, Colorado

Palisade is a statutory town in Mesa County, Colorado, United States. It is part of the Grand Junction Metropolitan Statistical Area. The population was 2,565 at the 2020 census. The community is nestled between the Book Cliff mountains and the Colorado River. Palisade is known for its peach orchards and wine vineyards and the multitude of



festivals based around its agriculture and live music. The climate, a 182-day growing season, and an average 78 percent of sunshine makes Palisade "The Peach Capital of Colorado".

Known as Colorado's fruit and wine county, Palisade is home to over 30 local wineries boasting award-winning vintages, tasting rooms, with majestic views of Mount Garfield and the Grand Mesa.

Outdoor enthusiasts will enjoy plenty to occupy themselves with access to over 50 mountain bike trails, Colorado River rafting, hunting, fishing, and local fruit stands. There are several nationally recognized annual festivals including the Colorado Wine Festival, Palisade Peach Festival, Palisade Bluegrass & Roots Festival, and the Palisade Farmer's Market voted number three in the nation. Eash of these events bring anywhere from 2,000 to 20,000 visitors.



# **About the Department**

The Palisade Fire Department was originally founded in 1907 as the Palisade Volunteer Fire Department. Today it serves as an all-hazards emergency response and transport agency responding to approximately 1,100 requests for emergency service from one strategically located station. We operate three platoon shifts currently consisting of one Shift Lieutenant, two Full-time Firefighters, one Part-time Firefighter and Volunteer personnel each day. Shifts are on a 48/96 rotation.

We provide fire and medical services to the Town of Palisade and the Palisade Rural Fire Protection District. This encompasses approximately 59 square miles.

The department is extremely active in a multitude of community events annually to include festivals, school education programs, etc.

The fire department operates 1- Class A Engine, 1, Type 4 Brush Truck, 1 – Type 2 Tactical Tender, 2 – ALS/BLS ambulances, 2 – Squads, 1 - Polaris 1000 with approval to purchase a new Type 6 Brush Truck anticipated to arrive in August of 2024.



## **General Position Summary**

The Shift Lieutenant functions as a first level working supervisor responsible for the daily operation and function of station apparatus and equipment and serves to support the Fire Chief in the management of all staff members assigned to their shift either permanently or temporarily. The Shift Lieutenant will work directly with the Fire Chief to assess and improve training needs for the shift personnel and department.

Successful candidates must be able to work independently, with limited supervision, in a production-oriented position. Successful candidates must possess customer service skills with the ability to work with others and be able to communicate effectively verbally and in writing while demonstrating a professional demeanor and attitude. Successful candidates must have experience using a computer with specific knowledge of database and word processing systems.

- NREMT or Colorado State EMT with IV certification (must be on Mesa County Protocol within 6 months of hire)
- NWCG Firefighter II or greater
- NIMS 100/200/300/700/800
