

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PALISADE BOARD OF TRUSTEES November 12, 2024

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees for the Town of Palisade was called to order at 6:00 pm by Mayor Greg Mikolai with Trustees present: Stan Harbaugh, Jeff Snook, Sarah Matchett, Rick Fox, and Mayor Pro-Tem Jamie Somerville. Absent was Trustee Nicole Maxwell. Also in attendance were Town Manager Janet Hawkinson, Town Clerk Keli Frasier, Fire Chief Charles Balke, Community Development Director Devan Aziz, Special Event Coordinator Rebecca Loucks, and Finance Director Gregg Mueller.

AGENDA ADOPTION

PRESENTATIONS

Jessica Burford, Palisade Chamber of Commerce President and CEO gave a presentation about the Palisade Chamber of Commerce activities and goals and requested funding for 2025.

TOWN MANAGER REPORT

Community Development Director Devan Aziz reviewed the request from Mr. and Mrs. Solomon for a modification of the rules regarding the location of their recently constructed fence.

The consensus of the Board is to allow the fence to remain, but that if anything else is built in the perimeter, it will be torn down, and being in the right of way, any sidewalk improvements would trigger the necessity for the fence to be removed and moved.

Town Manager Janet Hawkinson reviewed the multiple sidewalk projects being led by the Town of Palisade.

ORDINANCE 2024-08 - Proposed vacation of right-of-way along 311 W Third St & 307 W Third St $\,$

Community Development Director Devan Aziz and Town Manager Hawkinson reviewed the staff report and history of the properties.

Mayor Mikolai opened the hearing to public comment.

Shaun Burns of Palisade, Tammy Craig of Palisade, Juliann Adams of Palisade, Eric Cry – architect of the proposed project, Scott High of Palisade, and Palisade Chamber of Commerce President Jessica Burford all spoke in favor of the vacation of right-of-way in order to allow for the proposed hotel project.

Mayor Mikolai opened the hearing to Board comment.

- Will the alleyway be required to turn into a one-way (no)
- How will this affect the alleyway in general
- Are adjacent property owners in favor (yes)
