PRO 2023-06 - Cadez Building Height Variance

Applicant Michael Cadez, the owner of 404 W 1st Street, gave a brief presentation regarding the request and emphasized that the requested height is consistent with the surrounding neighborhood and the historic aesthetic of the existing structure.




Benefits of a Water System Hydraulic Model

- ☐ Ability to evaluate performance of the distribution system;
- Fire Flow,
- Pressure zones,
- Age of water,
- Flow characteristics (trouble shoot old pipes),
- Aid in discovery of closed valves.
- ☐ Improved planned maintenance Unidirectional flushing program coordinated with valve exercising program.
- Aid in planning for Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) Projects. Identify improved service through; looped lines, elimination of aged water, mprove fire flow, undersized or oversized pipes.
- Evaluate system with future demands in mind and develop the CIP based on current and future system performance.




Town of Palisade | Water System Hydraulic Model
