In January 2021, we recycled 7 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard.

## Recycling these materials will save the following resources:

**114 Mature Trees**

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 1,945,600 sheets of printing and copy paper!

**17 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace**

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 19 people!

**14,564 Kw-Hrs of Electricity**

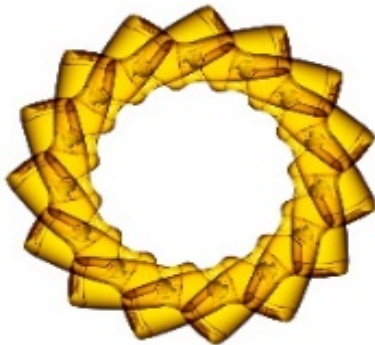
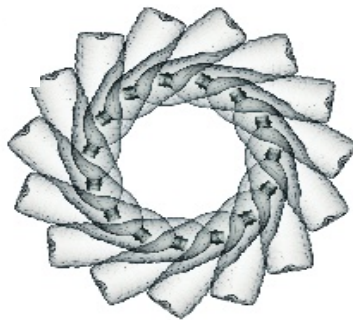
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 1 homes!

**Avoided 20 Metric Tons (MTCO<sub>2</sub>E) of GHG Emissions**

The recycling of these materials prevented these GHG emissions!

**34,854 Gallons of Water**
