In March 2021, we recycled 7 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard.

Recycling these materials will save the following resources:

114 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 1,940,200 sheets of printing and copy paper!

17 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 19 people!

14,523 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

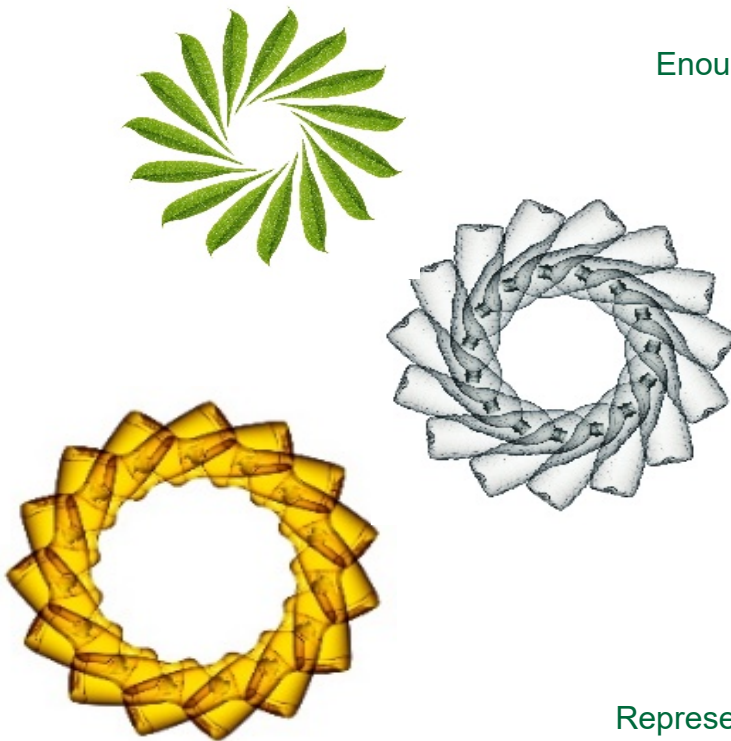
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 1 homes!

Avoided 20 Metric Tons (MTCO₂E) of GHG Emissions

The recycling of these materials prevented these GHG emissions!

34,756 Gallons of Water
