In October 2020, we recycled 10 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard.

Recycling these materials will save the following resources:

**158 Mature Trees**

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 2,685,500 sheets of printing and copy paper!

**24 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace**

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 26 people!

**20,102 Kw-Hrs of Electricity**

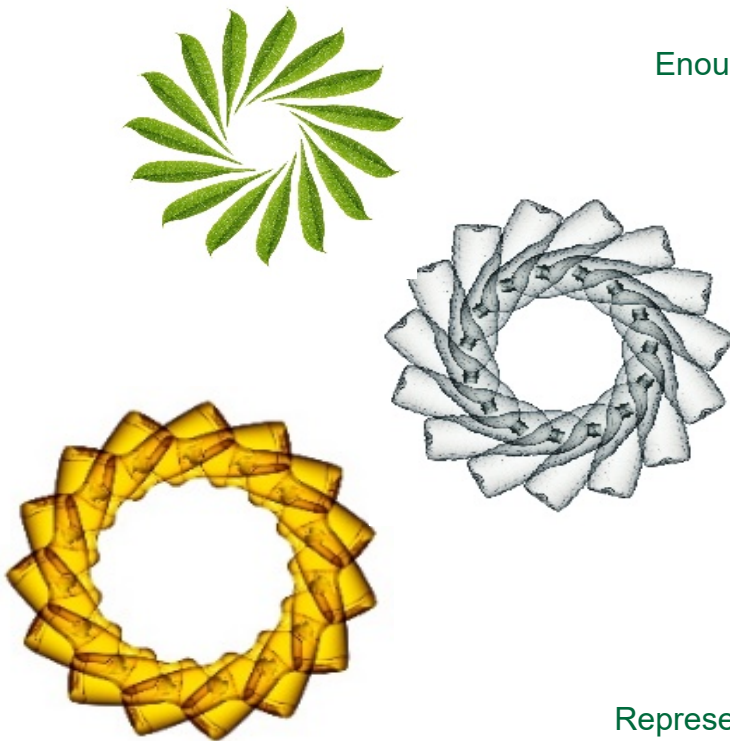
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 1 homes!

**Avoided 27 Metric Tons (MTCO<sub>2</sub>E) of GHG Emissions**

The recycling of these materials prevented these GHG emissions!

**48,109 Gallons of Water**

Represents enough saved water to meet the daily fresh water needs of 641 people!
