Stats for April 2023:

• The month of April had 243 Calls for Service.

Grand Junction Communication Call Summary:

To date, the Police Department had 1,017 calls for service. Last year at the end of April of 2022, we were sitting at around 1,113. We are currently at a 10% decrease in calls for service this year. Our response time to priority one emergency calls is 7:24 seconds. The call for service process takes 1-2 minutes: creating the call from dispatch, then dispatching an officer, and then travel time to the call location for the officer.

Traffic:

14 traffic citations were issued this month that included speeding, stop sign violations, and other moving violations.

Training:

- In-service training took place with officers completing 4 hours of DT, 3 hours of Search and Seizure, and 4 hours of driving at the CLETC driving track. We are on track to complete mandatory in-service training much earlier in the year so we can focus our attention on festivals, proactive patrol duties, and other special events in our community.
- > Detective Segers attended the STARK symposium about sex assault investigations.
- Lt. Post completed the third and final week of LPO (Leading Police Organizations). This training offers strategies in improving operations within a police department from a police management perspective.

Investigations:

Multiple reported Fraud cases reported in December that are still open. These cases are complex and require multiple warrants and the production of records to investigate. One fraud case was concluded with a felony arrest warrant issued, and officers promptly executed the warrant.

Significant Events:

- We are now fully staffed and working towards continued growth and improvement. The officers we have are vigilant and working hard to address known complaints areas with traffic and other various issues to better our services.
- > Officers participated in an increased traffic enforcement period with other local agencies.
- The new Patrol unit was delivered and is a great hit. We have received multiple compliments on the new graphics and look. We are looking to upgrade our current graphics to the new design on the older police units this year.
- Town Board Trustee Bill Carlson signed up for a ride -along and experienced a few hours riding with Sgt. Dan Dranginis. I received feedback from Trustee Carlson, which was very much appreciated.

Message from Chief Jesse James Stanford:

As we move forward into May and closer to Bluegrass Festival, we have some new police officers experiencing festival season in Palisade for the first time as a member of the Town of Palisade Police Department. We also have police staff who have experience with festival season and other events in Palisade, so I am excited to have such a well-balanced police staff who are focused on the community. Our goals are simple: provide public safety through "Community, Courage, and Compassion." The Board of Trustees are always invited to sign up for a ride-a-long with a Palisade Officer so you can experience first-hand the professionalism and compassion the police staff offers to the community through our public safety mission.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: Town staff mapped and measured potholes that were able to be repaired using hot mix asphalt patching. Staff then solicited bids from three (3) local contractors for approximately 2237 square feet of repair. The following bids were received:

- 2. Valley Pavement Maintenance \$64,157.50
- 3. United Companies (verbal only) \$96,000.00



<u>SUBJECT:</u> Purchase of Playground Equipment for Veterans Memorial Park

<u>SUMMARY</u>: Veterans Memorial Park has a children's playground on the west side of the park, adjacent to Kluge Avenue. The playground equipment is nearing the end of its useful life and is not compliant with today's standards for safety.

The Town has budgeted \$75,000 towards replacing the equipment, which includes \$50,000 paid by the owners of the Winding River Mobile Home Park on W. 8th Street (one block west of the park) as a Developer Fee in Lieu of Parks, with the remaining \$25,000 from the Colorado Lottery Conservation Fund, whose funds are restricted to improving parks, outdoor spaces, and recreation areas.

The Town has solicited proposals for this equipment and received three (3) responses. All three proposals have been evaluated by staff and were brought to the Palisade Planning Commission on April 18, 2023 for feedback. Based on this feedback, the overwhelming direction is to move forward with a Burke play system from A to Z Recreation. Plans and drawings from this proposal are attached.

The Town will solicit feedback from the public on various color options available for this system prior to purchase.
