MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PALISADE TOURISM ADVISORY BOARD February 9, 2023

The regular meeting of the Tourism Advisory Board for the Town of Palisade was called to order at 9:06 am by Chair Juliann Adams with members present: Vice Chair Ryan Robinson, Jean Tally, Cassidee Shull, Rondo Buecheler, Jeff Snook, Ashley McGee, and Trustee Turner. Absent were Jeff Hanle, Tim Wenger, and Jessica Burford. A quorum was declared. Also in attendance were Town Manager Janet Hawkinson, Town Clerk Keli Frasier, Community Development Director Brian Rusche, and Melita Pawlowski with Slate Communications Marketing.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion #1 by Mayor Pro-Tem Turner, seconded by C. Shull, to approve the Agenda as presented.

M. Paelowski updated the Board on the status and progress of the website redesign, as well as 2022 Quarter 4 reports, and statistics of the ongoing ad campaigns.

Motion #3 by R. Buecheler, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Turner to increase the advertising budget by \$3,600.00 to keep the iHeart Radio advertising as-is and not loose any targeted audiences.

Byway Signs

Community Development Director Rusche and the Board discussed what signs have been ordered and what the Board views a the priority for replacements.

The consensus of the Board is to move forward with a discussion with the Board of Trustees to replace the TODDs signs on East and West I-70, and who should pay for them.

Look at new loops for Fruit & Wine Byway map adding West assets 'Ride GPS'

Chair Adams advised the Board that she's had Clifton, CO businesses approach and ask how to be on the Fruit & Wine Byway.

The consensus of the Board is to keep the byway as the 81526 zipcode area, and not change the byway trail until the State of Colorado Scenic Byway Applications open.
