A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF PALISADE, COLORADO SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR A SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANT FROM THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF MULTI-USE PATHS ALONG HIGHWAY 6 FROM TAYLOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO THE PALISADE HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Town of Palisade is requesting from the Colorado Department of Transportation for the construction of multi-use bike and pedestrian paths along Highway 6 (the "Project") through the Safe Routes to School Program Grant (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Town of Palisade supports the Grant application and if the Grant is awarded, the Town of Palisade supports the completion of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF PALISADE, COLORADO THAT:

- Section 1: The Board of Trustees of the Town of Palisade strongly supports the application for the Grant and has appropriated matching funds for this Grant with Colorado Department of Transportation.
- Section 2: If the Grant is awarded, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palisade strongly supports the completion of the Project.
- Section 3: The Board of Trustees of the Town of Palisade authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any Grant awarded.
- Section 4: If the Grant is awarded, the Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign the Grant agreement with the Colorado Department of Transportation.
- Section 5: This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval


